Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

In this 2nd event of our weUESoUD project, we started working on the objectives we proposed in our application, namely the first theme: "Portuguese women, against the totalitarian regime of the New State in Portugal, before the revolution of April 25th 1974".

We highlight in the activities that took place during the days of the event, the 2nd day of activities with the official presentation of the project to the local community and the media in the building of the City Hall of Gondomar. In this place we also had the signing of the twinning pact, with flags, representations and anthems, which was attended by the Mayor and several authorities. Still during the morning, we had in the auditorium of the Junta de Freguesia of Baguim do Monte, a round table: "The Democratic Revolutions - the role, representation and perspective of women in these important events". In the afternoon we went to the auditorium of the Amália Rodrigues Cultural Center to hold a conference on "Portuguese women against the totalitarian regime of the Estado Novo in Portugal before April 25, 1974. In this auditorium we could count on the presence of the students of the Senior University of Rio Tinto, as well as its Academic Band that gave us a performance.

The 3rd day was dedicated to getting to know the people and customs of the region, namely through a visit to a ROTA DA FILIGRANA workshop in Gondomar and a cultural visit to the historic centre of Porto (World Heritage by UNESCO) and to the Port Wine Cellars.

With this event in Gondomar we were able to reach the project's target audience "the "daughters" (40 to 50 year old generation) and the "granddaughters" (15 to 30 year old generation) of women who were immortalized by the actions they developed and by the assumption of their right to be citizens. Our main target audience made up of the binomials Woman - mother, wife - daughter, was and is fundamental in the political and social struggles, so that today we can live in Freedom and Democracy".

We were able to carry out with great quality the actions that we proposed to do, namely the conference, round table, and cultural visits. In this way we have achieved, as we proposed, an

exchange of experiences between the parties involved, with a constant encouragement of citizen's active participation in European social and political life. We continued in this event to create a solid and lasting relationship of cooperation between all local and foreign partners, which translated into an opportunity for broadening perspectives, cultural enrichment, and human development for the participants.
